## Supreme Court Denies Cert in *Hertz*, Leaving Third Circuit's Solvent-Debtor Interest Ruling Intact

In *Hertz*, the U.S. Supreme Court denied certiorari, leaving intact the Third Circuit's holding that creditors of a solvent-debtor are entitled to contractual post-petition interest and redemption premiums ahead of equity under a Chapter 11 plan. The Supreme Court had previously declined to review similar rulings involving the solvent-debtor exception from the Fifth and Ninth Circuits. The solvent-debtor exception requires a creditor of a solvent debtor to receive contract-rate post-petition interest to be "unimpaired." The order preserves the ruling that Hertz's 2026/2028 noteholders are entitled to at least \$270 million in contractual post-petition interest and premiums, rather than federal judgment rate interest.

## iRobot Emerges from Chapter 11, Successfully Navigating Complex Cross-Border Transaction

The U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware confirmed Paul, Weiss client iRobot's prepackaged chapter 11 plan of reorganization on January 22, 39 days after the company filed for bankruptcy, with iRobot emerging one day later on January 23. Under the plan, Shenzhen PICEA Robotics Co., Ltd. and Santrum Hong Kong Co., Limited, collectively known as Picea, iRobot's secured lender and a global manufacturer and service provider, acquired all equity interests in iRobot through an equitizing transaction. The plan received broad stakeholder support, with unanimous approval from all classes that voted on the plan. The transaction's closing marked iRobot's successful emergence from its prepackaged chapter 11 process, as it emerged with no funded debt and additional capacity to invest in the next generation of smart home robotics. The transaction navigated a complex regulatory environment given its cross-border nature, including engagement with the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States (CFIUS).
